Selection Criteria are the skills, abilities, knowledge, experience and/or qualifications required to be able to carry out the duties of this post.

Please, therefore, **address each criterion listed below, specifically and clearly**, drawing upon all of your experience, whether it has been gained at home, work or on a voluntary basis.

A thorough understanding of domestic abuse, its dynamics and its impact on survivors and their children.	Essential
A good understanding of housing and homelessness issues in relation to domestic abuse and the barriers faced by survivors trying to access housing services.	Essential
An understanding of partnership working in a multi-agency, multi-disciplinary setting, ideally with an understanding of interventions that address domestic abuse.	Essential
Excellent interpersonal skills, in particular an ability to negotiate with and influence partnership colleagues to ensure effective delivery of project objectives and outcomes.	Essential
Experience of working to organisational and multi-agency protocols and/or developing protocols, procedures and best practice guidance.	Essential
An understanding of and a commitment to Equal Opportunities in employment and in service delivery.	Essential
A proven ability to manage a time-limited project with specific outcomes and work with minimum supervision.	Essential
An understanding of the monitoring of outcomes, project evaluation and documentation.	Essential
Strong excellent written, verbal, computer and presentation skills.	Essential
An ability to work under pressure with excellent time management and organisational skills including the ability to meet tight deadlines.	Essential
